

### PASSOVER DISCUSSION TOPICS FOR TEENS



1. The Jewish people were slaves for many years, and during the Pesah story we see the journey to their freedom. What are you a slave to today? Money? Technology? Plastic? How is it impacting the world we live in? What small and large steps can you take to free yourself?
2. The Pesah seder highlights four sons: wicked, wise, simple, and the one who does not know how to ask. At what moments in your life do you display characteristics of each of the children?
3. In Judaism it is customary to invite guests to your seder, specifically someone who may not have a seder to attend. If you could invite anyone in the world, living or not, to our seder, who would you invite?
4. What does modern-day freedom look like to you? Who is someone that you look up to who is fighting for freedom? In what ways are people being targeted and limited?
5. If you had to wander in the desert for 40 years, what are the most important items you would bring with you?
6. Moses is one of the most famous Jewish leaders. What qualities did he possess that make him a leader? Who do you think is an influential leader today? Do they possess similar qualities?
7. Why do you think the Pesah seder is one of the most practiced Jewish rituals of all time?
8. If you were Miriam leading the Jewish people through the sea to freedom, what song would you sing and why?
